An associate degree or higher is required to become a Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselor. This certificate is designed for individuals holding a degree, but needing the additional DSHS licensing requirements.

Regional Labor Market Information

Substance Abuse and Behavioral Disorder Counselors: New workers generally start around \$28,515. Normal pay for Substance Abuse and Behavioral Disorder Counselors is \$37,649 per year, while highly experienced workers can earn as much as \$51,085 in this region. Over the last year, 30 companies have posted 231 jobs for Substance Abuse and Behavioral Disorder Counselors.
