### **Career Information**

Assist lawyers by investigating facts, preparing legal documents, or researching legal precedent. Conduct research to support a legal proceeding, to formulate a defense, or to initiate legal action.

### **Regional Labor Market Information**

Paralegals: New workers generally start around \$32,714. Normal pay for Paralegals and Legal Assistants is \$48,013 per year, while highly experienced workers can earn as much as \$71,587. Over the last year, 95 companies have posted 511 jobs for Paralegals and Legal Assistants in this region. There are currently 3,153 Paralegals and Legal Assistants that are employed in Austin-Round Rock, TX. ### **Transfer Information**

The Associate of Applied Science Paralegal degree is aimed at students who do not plan to work toward a 4-year degree; however, a Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) is an excellent alternative to a BA or BS degree. These degrees apply non-transferable courses and work experience towards the degree. You still must meet general education requirements and take upper level courses.
